

SANTI WANGCHUAN (b. 1988, Thailand)

Santi Wangchuan makes hand-woven works inspired by his family's traditions, reflecting an integration of religion, stories, equipment, and tools that are native to his hometown in Thailand. Born into a family of traditional weavers, he acquired the skill at a young age from his grandmother; and through his mixed media work, he resourcefully preserves an art technique that is soon to be lost, continuing the conservation of his culture. Wangchuan earned a Bachelor of Fine Arts in Thai Art (Second Class Honors) from the Faculty of Painting Sculpture and Graphic Arts, Silpakorn University, and recently graduated with an MFA in Visual Arts, the Faculty of Painting Sculpture and Graphic Arts, Silpakorn University, Bangkok. He was awarded the "3rd Honoured Bronze Award" at the 61st National Exhibition of Art, Bangkok, Thailand in 2015 and has participated in multiple art exhibitions, such as the 35th Bualuang Painting Exhibition, The Queen's Gallery, Bangkok in 2013, and the Amata Foundation's 'Art Awards'.
