She was the recipient of the IMPART award by Art Outreach in 2019. Dia was an Artist-in-Residence at the NTU Centre for Contemporary Art Singapore in 2022 and was selected for the by SEA AiR-Studio Residencies at the Jan van Eyck Academie in the Netherlands from April to July 2023.







Italian philosopher Giambattista Vico described time as a spiral, an endless cycle of recurrences of development and collapse. Time to Vico is constantly rebirthed through civilisations both lost and existing.
